SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

The LegalPedia Journal® (LPJ) (ISSN 2581-7949) requests the Contributors/Author(s) to comply with the following guidelines: -

Well researched & original papers, case studies, Articles, book review are invited from academics/scholars, researchers, bar & bench, and the students. All manuscripts should be original and should not be simultaneously considered by any other publication/journal, *co-authorship to a maximum number of one author is permitted.* The LPJ accepts manuscripts for publication on a rolling basis throughout the year and the submissions made thereafter might be considered for publication in the next issue/volume.

1. Types of Manuscript

LegalPedia Journal® publishes the following Manuscript on the topic related to law: -

1. Research Paper: - (4000-6000 words including footnotes as well as abstract not exceeding 250-300 words.)
2. Articles: - (4000- 5000 words inclusive of footnotes)
3. Essay: - (3500 words inclusive of footnotes)
4. Case Comment: - (2000-3000 words inclusive of footnotes)
5. Book Review: - (5000 words inclusive of footnotes)

2. How to submit

- a) LJP only accepts electronic submissions. Submissions have to be submitted only to this email editorialboard@legalpediajournal.com. We shall only accept manuscripts submitted through above mentioned Email I'd only. No hard copies or submissions made to any other Email I'd will not be entertained.
- b) The manuscript should be in **.docx format**. All manuscripts must also contain an abstract of not more than 300 words. Title of the paper should be in capital bold and centre aligned. The name of author and co-author (if any), should appear in the next line and should be right aligned. The name of the author should be followed by footnote mark (*) for the first author and (**) for the second/co author. The above-mentioned footnotes should consists details of Author(s) such as educational qualifications and the institutional/organisational details along with E-mail address of the author(s).
- c) Garamond, 12 pt., 1.5 spacing, 1-inch gap on all four sides.

Citation Format: Only footnotes may be used as the form of citations. End notes shall not be accepted. All footnotes must be in single-spacing and justified.

For format of footnotes please refer Bluebook (19th Edition) Citation Format.

Plagiarism: All the contributions should be the original work of the contributors/author(s) and should not have been submitted for consideration in any other Journal/publication. All the contributions shall be put through “**plagiarism check software**” and any plagiarized work will be out rightly rejected. The contributions presented to and accepted for publication and the copyrights therein shall be the intellectual property of the Law Review.

3. The Procedure for Acceptance

- a) On receipt of the contribution, the Editorial Committee shall screen it to satisfy itself about the conformity of the contribution with the LPJ conditions, policy, scheme and style for submission of the manuscripts.

- b) It is mandatory to send an abstract while submitting the manuscript under the head of Research paper and Article of not more than 300 words including key words. Every abstract should contain at least 3 keywords denoting the theme and relevance of main manuscript.
- c) The screened work shall be assessed by the nominated referees.
- d) A contribution recommended by the referee as fit for publication as such or recommended for publication with necessary amendments, if any, shall be considered for publication after the author would submit the amended paper accordingly. The author will be given two weeks (2 weeks) to carry out changes thus suggested.

Format: The LegalPedia Journal® (LPJ) (ISSN 2581-7949) is an **'Online Journal' i.e. (E-Journal)** and will publish the selected work/manuscript in its journal on its website i.e. www.legalpediajournal.com. Contributors however would be provided with the journal issue in the form of an e-copy on their respective e-mail id's along with a "Certificate of Publication" in LPJ through Speed-Post on their respective addresses.
